Jordan Evangelical Theological Seminary is an accredited seminary in Amman, Jordan. JETS students come from twenty-two countries throughout the Middle East and North Africa, and JETS graduates serve in twenty-one different countries around the world.

Dr. Imad Shehadeh is the current president of JETS. Educated at Dallas Theological Seminary, Imad and his wife Julia returned to Jordan to found JETS. One of Imad's areas of expertise is scholarship on the Trinity, a foundational theological truth that is a great stumbling block to Muslims.

Jordan is the most stable country in the Middle East, and the Jordanian monarchy works hard to maintain that stability. The government is currently conducting extensive financial audits of all entities receiving foreign funding to make sure that bad actors are not gaining influence in Jordan. JETS is also going through this audit, which is unfortunately hindering the seminary's ability to operate at full capacity.
