As each one is able, schedule time for fasting and prayer May 1<sup>st</sup>. This month's prayer calendar helps us to worship God our Father and our Lord Jesus Christ as we look into the meaning of and celebrate the words which the Holy Spirit through Paul the Apostle gave to us to pray: ...having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints... (Eph 1: 18)

FOR IN CHRIST JESUS WE ARE ACCEPTED, SECURE AND SIGNIFICANT!

I AM ACCEPTED! O my Father and my Lord Jesus Christ I give You thanks and praise for...

1.1 am a child of God! But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God...(Jhn 1:12)

2.1 am Christ's friend! No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. (Jhn 15:15)

3.I have been justified! Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom 5:1)

**4.**I am united with the Lord and I am one spirit with Him! **But he who is joined to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. (1Cor 6:17)** 

5. I have been bought with a price. I belong to God! Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body. (1Cor 6:19, 20)

6.I am a member of Christ's body! Now you are the body of Christ and individually members of it. (1Cor 12:27)

7.I am a saint! Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful <u>in Christ Jesus</u>...(Eph 1:1)

8.I have direct access to God through the Holy Spirit! And he came and preached peace to you who were far off and peace to those who were near. For through him we both have access in one Spirit to the Father. (Eph 2:17. 18)

**9.**I have been redeemed and forgiven of all my sins! **He has delivered us from the domain of darkness** and transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins. (Col 1: 13, 14)

**10.**I am filled in Christ Jesus in whom the whole fullness of deity dwells and who is the head of all rule and authority! For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority. (Col 2:9, 10)

I AM SECURE! O my Father and my Lord Jesus Christ, I give You thanks and praise for...

11.1 am free from condemnation! There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are <u>in</u> <u>Christ Jesus</u>. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free <u>in Christ Jesus</u> from the law of sin and death. (Rom 8:1,2)

**12.** I am assured that all things work together for good! **And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose. (Rom 8:28)** 

13.I cannot be separated from the love of God! Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, not things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom 8:35-37, 39)

14.I have been established, anointed, and sealed by God and given His Spirit in my heart! And it is God who establishes us with you <u>in Christ</u>, and has anointed us, and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee. (2Cor 1:21-22)

**15.**I am hidden with Christ in God! For you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. (Col 3:3)

**16.** I am confident that the good work God has begun in me will be perfected! **And I am sure of this, that** he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. (PhI 1:6)

17.I am a citizen of heaven! But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, (PhI 3:20)

**18.** I have not been given a spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind! ...for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control. (2Ti 1:7)

19.I can find grace and mercy to help in time of need! Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need. (Heb 4:14-16)

20.I am born of God and the evil one cannot touch me! We know that everyone who has been born of God does not keep on sinning, but he who was born of God protects him, and the evil one does not touch him. (1Jo 5:18)

I AM SIGNIFICANT! O my Father and my Lord Jesus Christ, I give You thanks and praise for...

21.1 am the salt and light of the earth! "You are the salt of the earth, but if salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything except to be thrown out and trampled under people's feet. "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden." (Mat 5:13-14)

22.I am a branch of the true vine, a channel of His life! "I am the true vine, and my Father is the vinedresser. ... I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. (Jhn 15:1, 5)

23.I have been chosen and appointed to bear fruit! You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit and that your fruit should abide, so that whatever you ask the Father in my name, he may give it to you. (Jhn 15:16)

24.I am a personal witness of Christ! "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

25.I am God's temple! Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's Spirit dwells in you? (1Cor 3:16)

26.I am a minister of reconciliation for God! Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; that is, <u>in Christ</u> God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that <u>in him</u> we might become the righteousness of God. (2Cor 5:17-21)

27.I am God's coworker (see 1Corinthians 3:9)! Working together with him, then, we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain. (2Cor 6:1)

28.1 am seated with Christ in the heavenly realm! But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ--by grace you have been saved-- and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus... (Eph 2:4-6)

**29.**I am God's workmanship! For we are his workmanship, created <u>in Christ Jesus</u> for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. (Eph 2:10)

**30.** I may approach God with freedom and confidence! This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized <u>in Christ Jesus our Lord</u>, <u>in whom</u> we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him. (Eph 3:11-12)

**31.**I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. I can do all things through Him Who strengthens me! Not that I am speaking of being in need, for I have learned in whatever situation I am to be content. I know how to be brought low, and I know how to abound. In any and every circumstance, I have learned the secret of facing plenty and hunger, abundance and need. I can do all things through him who strengthens me. (Philippians 4:11-13 ESV)
