Heavenly Father, give us grace to worship You in spirit and in truth as we praise You for the inexpressible gift of Your
only Son Jesus Christ the Lord, and placing us in Christ!

- 1. for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is <u>in Christ Jesus</u>, (Rom3:23-24) Our Father in heaven and our Lord Jesus Christ, we worship You! Lord Jesus what a price you paid to give us Your own right standing before God.
- 2. For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus. (Rom6:10-11) Holy Father, thank You that when Christ was crucified for us, we were crucified with Him. And when You raised Him from the dead, we were made alive to You!
- 3. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Rom6:23) Heavenly Father, you hate sin because it is done against You and because it destroys us. Thank you for Your free gift of eternal life in Christ Jesus!
- 4. There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. (Rom8:1) Father, I want to do right but evil lies close at hand: another law waging war against the law of my mind and making me captive to the law of sin that dwells in my members. Who will deliver me from this body of death? Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! (Rom7)
- 5. For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free <u>in Christ Jesus</u> from the law of sin and death. (Rom8:2) I praise You O God in this temple! For it is for freedom that Christ set us free! (Gal. 5:1)
- 6. For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another. (Rom 12:4-5)

 Heavenly Father, thank You that each of Your children are members of Your whole family in heaven and on earth. We are one Spirit with the Lord and members one of another!
- 7. In Christ Jesus, then, I have reason to be proud of my work for God. For I will not venture to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me to bring the Gentiles to obedience--by word and deed, (Rom15:17-18) Father, as Your servant and as a servant of the Lord Jesus Christ, may all I am, all I think and say and do be done as Christ Jesus lives His life in and through me.
- 8. Greet Prisca and Aquila, my fellow workers in Christ Jesus, ... Greet Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen and my fellow prisoners. They are well known to the apostles, and they were in Christ before me. (Rom16:3, 7) Father, thank You that in accord with Your love, wisdom, and power You have given each of Your children work to do according to Your purpose which You set forth in Christ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in Him, things in heaven and things on earth. (Eph 1:7-10)
- 9. To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours... (1 Cor1:2) We praise You, God our Father, that we have been set apart from sin in Christ Jesus!
- 10. I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was given you in Christ <u>Jesus</u>, that in every way you were enriched in him in all speech and all knowledge-- (1 Cor1:4-5)

 Father we give thanks to You for every one of Your children because of Your grace and the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ given to us who by Your grace are in Christ Jesus!

- 11. And because of him you are in Christ Jesus, who became to us wisdom from God, righteousness and sanctification and redemption, so that, as it is written, "Let the one who boasts, boast in the Lord." (1 Cor1:30-31) O Father, You chose what is foolish in the world, what is weak and what is low and despised in the world. No flesh can boast before You. We boast in the Lord our God for all You have given and made us in Christ Jesus!
- 12. But I, brothers, could not address you as spiritual people, but as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. (1 Cor3:1) Father, thank You that You have given the Holy Spirit and all the means for us to grow up in Christ Jesus!
- 13. For though you have countless guides <u>in Christ</u>, you do not have many fathers. For I became your father <u>in Christ Jesus</u> through the gospel. (1 Cor4:15) Father, thank You for sending laborers to us to bring the gospel which is the power of God for salvation for everyone who believes to the Jew first and also to the Greek.
- 14. That is why I sent you Timothy, my beloved and faithful child in the Lord, to remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach them everywhere in every church. (1 Cor4:17) Make me to know Your ways, O LORD; teach me Your paths. (Psalm 25:4)
- **15.** For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive. (1 Cor15:22) Lord Jesus, You are the resurrection and the life. You have been raised from the dead. The firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep and of those who remain. (1Cor 15:20)
- 16. I protest, brothers, by my pride in you, which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die every day! (1 Cor15:31) O Father, give me grace that I would not account my life of any value nor as precious to myself, if only I may finish my course and the ministry that I received from the Lord Jesus, to testify to the gospel of the grace of God. (Acts 20:24)
- 17. My love be with you all in Christ Jesus. Amen. (1Cor16:24) Father, thank You that the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Spirit and that love is heart to heart with You and with our brothers and sisters in Christ.
- 18. And it is God who establishes us with you in Christ, and has anointed us, and who has also put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee. (2Cor1:21,22) Father, thank You that You establish, make firm, each of Your saints sealing us with the Holy Spirit and the Holy Spirit giving us gifts according to His will.
- 19. But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere. (2Cor2:14) Father, thank You that we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us.
- 20. For we are not, like so many, peddlers of God's word, but as men of sincerity, as commissioned by God, in the sight of God we speak in Christ. (2Cor2:17) Heavenly Father, give us grace that we may study to show ourselves approved unto You rightly dividing the Word of Truth and grace to speak the truth in love that we may proclaim the gospel clearly.
- 21. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. (2Cor 5:17) Heavenly Father, knowing that You made me in Your image and likeness as You formed me in my mother's womb, I marvel that you have called me to Yourself in Christ and made me a new creation all together in Him!

- 22. that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. (2Cor 5:19) Father, thank You that You counted my trespasses against Your only Son, Jesus, when He was on the cross so that I who was your enemy are now reconciled to You in Christ! What good news.
- 23. Have you been thinking all along that we have been defending ourselves to you? It is in the sight of God that we have been speaking in Christ, and all for your upbuilding, beloved. (2Cor12:19) Father, having put away falsehood, we pray that You will give us grace that each one of us would speak the truth with his neighbor for we are members one of another. (Eph4:25)
- 24. Yet because of false brothers secretly brought in--who slipped in to spy out our freedom that we have in Christ Jesus, so that they might bring us into slavery—(Gal2:4) Heavenly Father, thank you that it was for freedom Christ has set us free! Give us grace to stand firm therefore and not submit again to a yoke of slavery. (Gal5:1)
- 25. Yet we know that a person is not justified by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified. (Gal2:16) Father, we rejoice in You our God and thank You that it is by grace that we are saved through faith and that not of ourselves. It is Your gift! May we not boast in ourselves but only in Christ Jesus our Lord!
- 26. Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us--for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who is hanged on a tree"--so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised Spirit through faith. (Gal3:13-14) LORD, all glory and thanks to You that You are our shield, our very great reward! As You blessed Abraham and made him a blessing, so by Your grace that is ours in Christ Jesus, bless us and make us a blessing! (Genesis 12, 15)
- 27. Now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian, for in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God, through faith. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ. (Gal3:25-27) God our Father, we give You praise and thanks that though when we came into this world as a baby, we were Your offspring, now we are Your children, sons, and daughters of God our Father in Christ Jesus our Lord!
- 28. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are all one <u>in Christ Jesus</u>. (Gal3:28) Our Father, thank You that there is no respect of persons with You. We who were predestined in Christ Jesus are each individually members one of another each one accepted in the Beloved!
- 29. For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith working through love. (Gal5:6) Heavenly Father, thank You for freeing us from slavery to legalism, and to license so that we may love You truly and truly love one another!
- 30. Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, To the saints who are in Ephesus, and are faithful in Christ Jesus... (Eph1:1) Father, thank You that by Your grace You have made us saints in Christ Jesus our Lord and You enable us to be Your faithful servants who serve our Faithful Creator our Savior!
- 31. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us <u>in Christ</u> with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places... (Eph1:3) All glory, honor and praise be to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places!
