

Tulsa Bible Church Prayer Calendar October 2024

As each one is able, please join in fasting and prayer on October 1st, as we *meditate on unity by praying & practicing the "one-anothers" in Scripture.*

1. **Be devoted to one another with brotherly love.** Ro. 12:10a Love one another with brotherly affection.
2. **Outdo one another in showing honor.** Ro. 12:10b Outdo one another in showing honor.
3. **Live in harmony with one another.** Ro. 12:16 Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.
4. **Do not judge but build up one another.** Ro. 14:13 Therefore let us not pass judgment on one another any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother. Ro. 14:19 So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding.
5. **Welcome one another.** Ro. 15:7 Therefore welcome one another as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God.
6. **Instruct one another.** Ro. 15:14 I myself am satisfied about you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to instruct one another.
7. **Consider one another.** Php. 2:3 Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.
8. **Care for one another.** 1 Cor. 12:25 ...that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.
9. **Do not become conceited, provoke, envy one another.** Gal. 5:26 Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another.
10. **Bear one another's burdens.** Gal. 6:2 Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ.
11. **Speak truthfully to one another.** Eph. 4:25 Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members of one another. Eph 5:19...addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart...
12. **Be kind to one another.** Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you.
13. **Forgive one another.** Eph 4:32 Be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, as God in Christ forgave you. Col. 3:13 ...bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive.
14. **Be in submission to one another.** Eph. 5:21...submitting to one another out of reverence for Christ.
15. **Bear with one another.** Col. 3:13...bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also much forgive.

16. **Teach and admonish one another.** Col. 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
17. **Increase and abound in love for one another.** 1 Thes. 3:12...and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, as we do for you...
18. **Comfort one another.** 1 Thes. 4:18 Therefore encourage one another with these words.
19. **Encourage and build up one another.** 1 Thes. 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build one another up, just as you are doing.
20. **Be at peace with one another.** 1 Thes. 5:13...and to esteem them very highly in love because of their work. Be at peace among yourselves.
21. **Seek good for one another.** 1 Thes. 5:15 See that no one repays anyone evil for evil, but always seek to do good to one another and to everyone.
22. **Pray for one another.** 1 Tim. 2:1 First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people...
23. **Stir up one another.** Heb. 10:24 And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works...
24. **Do not speak against one another.** James 4:11 Do not speak evil against one another, brothers. The one who speaks against a brother or judges his brother, speaks evil against the law and judges the law. But if you judge the law, you are not a doer of the law but a judge.
25. **Do not grumble against one another.** James 5:9 Do not grumble against one another, brothers, so that you may not be judged; behold, the Judge is standing at the door.
26. **Confess to one another.** James 5:16 Therefore, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person has great power as it is working.
27. **Be hospitable to one another.** 1 Pet. 4:9 Show hospitality to one another without grumbling.
28. **Serve one another.** 1 Pet. 4:10 As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace...
29. **Be humble toward one another.** 1 Pet. 5:5 Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."
30. **Greet one another.** 1 Pet. 5:14 Greet one another with the kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ.
31. **Have fellowship with one another.** 1 John 1:7 But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin.
